



# Studio Arts

## Description

*Studio Arts follows the VCAA study design. The course aims to support students to recognise their individual potential as artists and develop their understanding and development of art making practices. Students learn how to explore, develop, refine, resolve and present artworks. Students investigate artist's artworks and artmaking practices.*

## Skill Development

*In these units of study, students develop an individual studio process to practise and refine specialised skills appropriate to particular art forms and media selected for art making. Students explore a range of art elements, art principles to develop their subject matter and ideas. Students apply skills in visual analysis, including the use of appropriate terminology in relation to their own artwork and artists studied. Students research aspects of the art industry including the presentation, conversation and marketing of artworks. Students develop a range of skills such as creativity; problem solving, self-management and communication.*

## Possible Assessment Tasks

*Folio, including artistic inspiration and techniques developing art ideas. Use of a wide range of techniques related to various art forms that communicate ideas. Art theory, a collection of artist investigations that demonstrate understanding of how artists use inspiration and make artworks. There will also be image analysis.*

## Activities/Camps/Excursions

*There will be an excursion to the Top Arts and Top Design exhibitions in Melbourne and also a visit to two professional galleries in Melbourne in Unit 4.*
